DEADLINE: Please submit your packet by June 7, 2024.

Applicants shall conform to all minimum requirements of the Civil Service Commission Rules for appointment unless otherwise stated herein and shall meet the following pre-requisites:

- a. Lateral transfer applicants must have previously been employed with an Ohio political subdivision as a full-time police officer.
- b. Lateral transfer applicants for the position of police officer shall meet the following additional pre-requisites at the time of application and appointment:
 - Applicant's current or previous employment shall have been the result of Civil Service examination process for police officer.
 - Applicant must be OPOTA certified/certifiable.
 - Applicants must successfully complete a physical agility test approved by the Civil Service Commission prior to appointment.

The Civil Service Secretary, along with the Police Chief, will review applications and determine which applicants meet the lateral hire criteria. Prior to appointment, lateral hire candidates shall submit to the following: in-person interviews, background investigation, ride along, polygraph/CVSA examination, physical agility testing, psychological examination, medical examination, drug screening. Positions filled through the lateral hire process are exempt from the written competitive examination.

All department probationary periods for new hires shall apply. Seniority shall be based on date of hire with the City of Rocky River.

Lateral Transfer Hiring Process

- Step 1: Applicants obtain and complete application packet.
- Step 2: Applicants return application with the designated timeframe.
- Step 3: Applicants are interviewed by Police and Human Resources staff.
- Step 4: Background checks are conducted, including polygraph or CVSA examination.
- Step 5: Civil Service Commission certifies hiring list. Successful completion of a physical agility test approved by the Civil Service Commission is required prior to appointment.
- Step 6: Meeting with Mayor and then conditional offer is made.
- Step 7: Successful completion of drug screen and psychological test.
- Step 8: Start date is established.
- Step 9: Swearing in ceremony.
- Step 10: Training program begins.
